

Style trend:

Voluminous Waves

Rounded, voluminous waves look beautiful on every face shape and hair texture, and they're trending this season. Whether you braid and follow with a flat iron to set the wave or use a waving iron (as shown on the model), brushing through the waves after they're set is what creates a soft, voluminous, hazy wave that is not too defined.



To create these abundant waves, Bea Carmichael, Global Educator, Hair Styling, prepped damp hair with **botanical repair™** bond-building styling creme to provide flexible hold and heat protection while she blow-dried and flat ironed the hair. Next, she sprayed subsections with air control™ light hold hair spray before clamping down the length of each subsection with a waving iron, clipping each wave in place to cool until all the hair was set. She removed the clips and gently combed through the top layers.

The bixie is proof positive that you don't need long hair to style it different ways; it can be sleek and smooth, textured and flipped on the edges and even voluminous depending on the products and techniques used. However the butterfly is personalized, there's a reason it's on trend—it's incredibly flattering and easy to style either done or undone.

You may not be 5'10" like Cindy Crawford, but you can totally have her hair. This season, some '90s-loving girls are embracing the trend of beautifully blown-out hair with tons of volume and bounce. This trend is perfect for women who want to look and feel as glam as a supermodel on the cover of *Mademoiselle*.



To create these glam waves, Bea Carmichael, Global Educator, Hair Styling, prepped damp hair with **pure abundance™ style-prep™** and **invati ultra advanced™ thickening foam** and blow-dried the hair with a round brush. Next, she sprayed subsections with **air control™ light hold hair spray** before curling each subsection with a large curling iron. She set each curl in a Velcro roller to cool until all the hair was set. She removed the rollers and brushed through the hair.



I For a bob with bounce, Bea Carmichael, Global Educator, Hair Styling, prepped damp hair with **pure abundance™ style-prep™** for weightless volume and performed a wrap-dry with a Denman brush until the roots were completely dry. She then switched to a round brush on the mid-lengths to ends.

✓ For a wavy style, Bea prepped damp hair with **be curly advanced™ curl enhancer cream** to prevent frizz and add shine and set the top of the head in loose pin curls. She then wet her hands and scrunched the water into the rest of the hair to create texture and wave, blow-dried with a diffuser and released the pin curls.



He then rolled the fringe toward the face in a large Velcro roller and completed the blow dry with a round brush. After removing the roller, Jae finished the style with **air control™ light hold hair spray**.



Vagus Nerve Stimulation

#vagusnervestimulation has been viewed more than 55 million times on TikTok. But what is the vagus nerve, and what does it do? The vagus nerve, or vagal nerves, are the primary nerves of the parasympathetic nervous system, which is responsible for several bodily functions, including heart rate, blood pressure, respiration, immune system and mood. The parasympathetic nervous system controls the body's "rest and digest" functions, whereas the sympathetic nervous system controls the body's "fight or flight" response. Stimulating the vagus nerve can help calm the body after one of those fight-or-flight responses. Deep breathing, humming or laughing can stimulate the vagus nerve.



Dolce Far Niente

Translated from Italian, dolce far niente means "the sweetness of doing nothing." Globally, people are over-scheduled, overworked and over-stressed. The good news is we've begun to take notice and take proactive steps to achieve greater work-life balance. The Italians are famous for this, engaging in the practice of doing nothing. So, clear your schedules and your minds, and say ciao to stress.



Aromatic 4-7-8 Breath

Also known as the "relaxing breath," the 4-7-8 focuses on deep breathing, which can reduce stress and anxiety, improve oxygen exchange, lower blood pressure and heart rate, reduce lactic-acid build-up and stimulate the lymphatic system to detoxify the body. When paired with essential oils, the positive effects can be even greater.

- 1 Apply a few drops or sprays of your favorite Aveda aroma to your inner wrists, and rub them together.
- 2 Place your inner wrists in front of your nose.
- 3 Inhale through your nose for a count of four.
- 4 Hold your breath for a count of seven.
- 5 Exhale through your mouth for a count of eight.
- 6 Repeat three more times for a total of four breath cycles.



Hara Hachi Bu

Many people in Okinawa, Japan, practice hara hachi bu, a concept that reminds them to stop eating when their stomachs are 80% full. This mindful way of eating highlights the difference between the phrases "I'm full" and "I'm no longer hungry." To put hara hachi bu into practice, try the following simple habits:

- Eat more slowly. Eating faster often means eating more. Slow down to allow your body to tell you it has had enough to eat.
- Focus on the meal only. Avoid eating in front of a screen or multi-tasking while eating. This will help you eat more mindfully and more slowly.
- Use small plates. Serving food on smaller plates makes it appear like you're enjoying a larger meal, which means vou'll eat less.




Limpia and Spiritual Hygiene

Spiritual wellness has been trending over the past year; however, energy work has deep roots in Latin American countries, Mexico in particular. *Limpia* derives from the Spanish word *limpiar*, meaning "to clean." The ancient Aztecs and Mayans believed that spiritual cleansing could affect physical, emotional and energetic well-being. During limpia sessions, a *curandera*, or healer, makes energetic adjustments to the body to cleanse it of unwanted energies and move it and the chakras back into balance.

- 1 Spray the hair with **botanical repair™ professional equalizing primer**, and comb through to distribute.
- 2 Take a center parting that extends down to the nape.
- 3 Take a triangle-shaped section that incorporates both sides of the center parting from 1" below the point of distribution, and apply **Formula A** from scalp to ends. Isolate with foil.
- 4 On both sides of the first triangle-shaped section, take another triangle-shaped section that is twice the size, and apply Formula B at the scalp and Formula C from mid-lengths to ends. Isolate with foil.
- 5 Next to each larger triangle-shaped section, take another triangle-shaped section that is the size of the first, and apply **Formula A** from scalp to ends. Isolate with foil.
- 6 Continue taking alternating large and small triangle-shaped sections and applying Formula A (smaller sections, scalp to ends) and Formulas B (larger sections, scalp) and C (larger sections, mid-lengths to ends), working around the head until you have one large triangle-shaped section remaining that sits on top of the head and incorporates both sides of the center parting. In this section, apply Formula B at the scalp and Formula C from mid-lengths to ends.
- 7 Along the hairline, apply Formula A at the scalp and Formula B from mid-lengths to ends. Isolate with foil.
- 8 Process for 40 minutes at room temperature. Do not use heat.



- 9 Rinse, shampoo with botanical repair™ strengthening shampoo and treat with botanical repair™ professional bond activator: light.
- 10 Process for 10 minutes, rinse and blow-dry.
- 11 Apply **Formula D** to all the hair.
- 12 Process for 20 minutes at room temperature. Do not use heat.
- 13 Rinse with cool water until the water runs clear. Do not shampoo.

Hair Style

- 1 Prep damp hair with botanical repair™ bond-building styling creme, blow-dry straight and smooth and follow with a flat iron.
- 2 Beginning in the nape, take a large, horizontal section, and divide it into three subsections.
- 3 Spray both the top and underside of the middle subsection with air control™ light hold hair spray, and wait two seconds to allow it to set.
- 4 Beginning three fingers from the root, clamp down the length of the subsection with a waving iron, and hold for a count of 10 with each clamp.
- 5 Repeat on the right and left subsections, securing each one to the middle subsection with hair clips.

- 6 Take another large section at the back of the head, and repeat the technique, beginning slightly closer to the root than the previous three subsections and holding for the same count of 10 with each clamp to ensure you create the same level of wave.
- 7 Continue working up the back of the head until all the hair is waved, clamping each set of subsections slightly closer to the root than the previous. NOTE: As you work up the head, switch
 - **NOTE:** As you work up the head, switch to **control force™ firm hold hair spray** to create more stability in the wave.
- 8 Repeat on the right and left sides of the head.
- Once all the hair is set in waves, remove the hair clips, and comb through the top layers of wave with a wide-tooth comb to break up the product without disturbing the set underneath.



Hair Cut

Back


- 1 Section the hair as illustrated.
- 2 Beginning in the center back and using a graduated technique, take a vertical subsection and cut a guide.
- 3 Continue by taking diagonal subsections, following the natural shape of the head and working toward the ear. Allow for additional length through the perimeter by elevating as you work toward the hairline just behind the ear.
- 4 Repeat on the opposite side.

Sides

- 5 Beginning on one side, take a horizontal subsection, and using the length from the previously cut subsection behind the ear as a guide, cut a square line to establish a new guide.
- 6 Continue taking horizontal subsections, elevating and overdirecting each subsection upward to retain length in the perimeter.
- 7 Beginning at the front of the same side, refine by taking diagonal subsections and cutting from short to long, working toward the ear until complete.
- 8 Repeat on the opposite side.

Top

- Take a vertical subsection though the center top, elevate to 90° and cut a guide from short to long.
- 10 Using the center section as a guide, take diagonal subsections, and cut from short to long in a concave manner, creating a disconnected top. Overdirect each subsection to the previously cut subsection.
- 11 Repeat on the opposite side.
- 12 Refine the top by taking horizontal subsections and texturizing with a razor.
- 13 Blow-dry the hair, and texturize to refine the hair cut.

- 3 Apply **Formula B** to the new growth area of all the hair.
- 4 Process until pale yellow at room temperature. Do not use heat.
- 5 Rinse, shampoo with **botanical repair™ strengthening shampoo** and towel-dry.
- 6 Apply **Formula C** to all the hair.
- 7 Process for 10–15 minutes at room temperature. Do not use heat.
- 8 Rinse, shampoo with **botanical repair™ strengthening shampoo** and towel-dry.
- 9 Apply **Formula D** to all the hair.
- 10 Process for 10 minutes at room temperature. Do not use heat
- 11 Rinse, shampoo with **botanical repair™ strengthening shampoo** and treat with **botanical repair™ professional bond activator: light**.





- Beginning in the back hairline, take light-density, fine-effect weaves, and apply **Formula A** using a babylights technique to the first 1–1½."
- 4 In sections 1 and 2, take 1," heavy-density, strong-effect slices, use a blow dryer to air-touch each slice and apply **Formula A** 2" off the scalp. Leave out one slice every three foils.
- 5 Repeat in section 3 until you reach the top of the crown, and then take ½," heavy-density, medium-effect weaves, and apply **Formula A** 2" off the scalp.

- 6 Along the front hairline, take light-density, fine-effect weaves, and apply **Formula A** using a babylights technique to the first 1–1½."
- 7 In sections 4 and 5, take ½–½," heavy-density, strong-effect slices, use a blow dryer to air-touch each slice and apply **Formula A** 2" off the scalp. Leave out one slice every three foils.
- 8 In section 6, take light-density, fine-effect weaves, and apply **Formula A** using a babylights technique to the first ½," and then take heavy-density, strong-effect slices and apply Formula A to the next ½." Leave out one slice every three foils.
- 9 Complete section 6 by taking heavy-density, strong-effect slices, use a blow dryer to air-touch each slice and apply **Formula A** 2" off the scalp. Leave out one slice every three foils.
- 10 Process until pale yellow at room temperature. Do not use heat.
- 11 Rinse, shampoo with **botanical** repair™ strengthening shampoo and treat with **botanical** repair™ professional bond activator: rich.
- 12 Process for 10 minutes, rinse and blow-dry.



- 14 Beginning at the bottom and working up, apply Formulas B and C from roots to ends as illustrated, isolating each section with foil.
 - **NOTE:** Do not apply color to the scalp.
- 15 Apply **Formula B** to the front and top sections.
- 16 Process for 20 minutes at room temperature. Do not use heat.
- 17 Rinse with cool water until the water runs clear. Do not shampoo.

Hair Style

- 1 Prep damp hair with be curly advanced™ curl perfecting primer, and style with be curly advanced™ curl enhancer cream.
- 2 Set the hair in finger coils, and blow-dry with a hard diffuser until 100% dry.
- Dispense 2−3 drops of **nutriplenish multi-use hair oil** in your hands, and
 scrunch it into the hair to break the cast.
- 4 Finish the style with brilliant™ medium hold hair spray, scrunch it into the hair and use the cool setting on the blow dryer to set it and seal the cuticle.







- 4 Using a large curling iron, roll the subsection from roots to ends, and hold for a count of 10.

- Release the curl, and secure it around a large Velcro roller to hold the curl in place and support it as it cools.
- 6 Continue working up the head in a bricklay pattern until all the hair in the back section is curled and secured in Velcro rollers.
- 7 Take a horseshoe-shaped section from recession point to recession point that incorporates the back bricklayed section, and clip it away.
- 8 Complete the side sections in the same manner as the back section, working in horizontal subsections and placing the Velcro rollers on base for maximum root lift, until you reach the top horseshoe-shaped section.
- 9 Complete the top horseshoe-shaped section in the same manner as the side sections, rolling all subsections away from the face, except for the front subsection along the hairline, which should be rolled toward the face.
- 10 Once all the curls are 100% cool, remove the Velcro rollers, gently twisting the hair as you remove each one.
- 11 Brush through the hair with a flat brush.



Hair Cut

- 1 Section the hair as illustrated.
- 2 Beginning at the nape, take a diagonal subsection, and use the razor to cut a guide.
- 3 Continue taking diagonal subsections, elevating slightly as you work up the back section.
- 4 As you reach the sides, overdirect subsections to preserve length and weight through the front.
- 5 Once you reach the top, take horizontal subsections, and lower the elevation to preserve length until complete.
- 6 Check both sides for balance.
- 7 **OPTIONAL:** Create a fringe suitable for the guest.
- 8 Blow-dry the hair, and texturize to refine the hair cut.





- 1 Prep damp hair generously with pure abundance™ style-prep,™ focusing the application at the roots.
- 2 Beginning in the nape, wrap-dry the hair with a Denman brush, lifting the hair at the roots.
 - **NOTE:** Perform the blow-dry with the hair saturated to manipulate the hair into the desired direction and shape.
- 3 Once the roots are 100% dry, switch to a round brush on the mid-lengths to ends to create bounce and a bevel on the ends.

Aqua Wave shown above

- Apply be curly advanced[™] curl enhancer cream to damp hair.
- 2 Set the top half of the head in loose pin curls.
- 3 Spray your hands with water, and scrunch it into the mid-lengths and ends of the hair not set in pin curls to create texture and wave.
- 4 Blow-dry with a hard diffuser until the hair is 100% dry.
- 5 Release the pin curls.



Hair Cut

Sides and back

- 1 Section the hair as illustrated.
- 2 Beginning on the right side, take a vertical subsection, elevate it straight up and cut a guide.
- 3 Continue taking vertical subsections, working toward the back. Overdirect the subsections at the top to create concave square layers, making the bottom gradually longer.
- 4 Continue in this manner until the section is complete.
- 5 Repeat on the opposite side.
- 6 Check both sides for balance.
- 7 In the back, take a vertical subsection, elevate it straight up and cut.


- 8 Continue taking vertical subsections, overdirecting each subsection to the previously cut subsection until the back is complete.
- 9 Comb the hair down to its natural fall, and cut it to a blunt line with a round shape.

Top

- 10 In the back crown section, take a vertical subsection, elevate it straight up and cut a guide.
- 11 Continue taking vertical subsections and cutting round layers, following the shape of the head, until the top section is complete.

Square-line fringe

- 12 Create the desired triangular parting.
- 13 Blunt-cut the fringe to a square line with the length between the eyes and eyebrows.
- 14 Take a vertical subsection from the top to the side of the face, overdirect it to the front and cut.
- 15 Continue in this manner to create graduation around the face and along the jawline.
- 16 Repeat on the opposite side.
- 17 Blow-dry the hair, and texturize to refine the hair cut.







After Care



- 7 Process until pale yellow at room temperature. Do not use heat.
